

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The following guidelines are in effect for all events held at The Links at Spring Church. These policies are designed to provide the best service and food quality possible to all of our guests.

SPIRIT OF THE GAME: Golf relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for others and to abide by the rules of the game. Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. Abuse of golf course, clubhouse, golf carts, or staff, will result in the removal of those individuals from the property.

CANCELLATION POLICY: The guaranteed number may not be less than the minimum number of golfers at the time of booking. You will be billed for the minimum guaranteed attendance number. Fees for the full minimum number of golfers becomes due and payable immediately if the event is canceled less than two weeks prior to the event's scheduled date.

BILLING/ SERVICE CHARGE/SALES TAX: All payment for your function is to be paid in full at the completion of your event or within 7 business days after completion with prior approval from management. An automatic 30% gratuity and 6% sales tax are included with all event pricing. Cash, check, or credit card, are acceptable methods of payment. Please confirm payment options at the time of booking. **If your group is tax exempt, you must furnish appropriate forms at the time of booking.**

DRESS CODE: Resort casual is the rule. No denim or sleeveless/collarless shirts are allowed on the golf course and appropriate attire is expected throughout the property. Golf shoes/sneakers are acceptable - metal spikes are not allowed. Please convey our dress code to your guests, as they may be asked to leave for not complying.

DECORATIONS AND SIGNS: Do not attach posters, signage, or decorations of any kind to walls, doors, or ceilings with tape, nails, tacks, screws or other fasteners. Notify staff of any banners that need to be suspended. Use of glitter, balloons, confetti, etc., is discouraged and may incur additional cleaning fees.

PARKING: Free parking is available for up to 120 guests.

PRE-EVENT ACCESS: Groups will have access to Brennan's Pub the evening before, unless an event is scheduled the morning of your event. In this case, please contact us to arrange another time. Outsourced rental items and flowers, décor, etc., must be delivered and setup by the person reserving the room or by someone they appoint to do so. The Links is not responsible for the placement or breakdown/return of these items and is not responsible for anything left behind from your event. All items must be removed from the property at the conclusion of your event unless previous arrangements have been made with management.

AV EQUIPMENT: Brennan's Pub's smart TVs support audio/visual presentations from laptops. You are encouraged to bring your own laptop and have it here no later than 3pm on the day before or day of your event depending on event start time.

PROPERTY LIABILITY: The cost of repairing or replacing any Links property broken or damaged or removed by a guest will be charged to the designee responsible for payment. The Links is not responsible for any items lost, left unattended, or not removed after the scheduled event by a guest or third party vendor. Unless otherwise arranged, items left behind will be discarded after three days.

HALFWAY HOUSE USAGE: The Halfway House is to be staffed by Links personnel. A rental fee may be charged if a Links staff member is not present. Volunteers may assist Links personnel at no charge.

BRENNAN'S PUB RENTAL: Brennan's Pub is available for private parties at a rate of \$500 for 4 hours. This rental fee includes the cost of a bartender and normal cleaning/maintenance of the facility. You may provide a floor plan and dance floor. Links staff will assist as needed to ensure proper set up of the venue at no extra charge. Charges may be incurred for extraordinary cleaning needs or damages caused by your guests. When catering is provided by Pub staff, there is no room rental charge.

MENU SELECTION: Groups of 10 or more must have a pre-selected menu OR order from a limited ala carte menu. Once your booking has been approved, menu selections will be forwarded via email from which to make your selections. We are happy to personalize menu options and can offer Vegetarian, Vegan and Gluten-Free meals, if needed. If pre-approval has been given, outside donated product is allowed. Your group is then subject to a determined facility service fee /cooking fee. Potential additional fees include a \$250 fee if a bartender/server is required to be provided due to donated product.

GUEST COUNTS: An estimated guest count is required when you book the event with a guarantee 2 days prior to your event. Failure to provide a guarantee will result in charges for the estimate given at booking or the actual number of guests, whichever is greater. No reductions in guest count are allowed within 48 hours of your event. No leftover food may be removed from the premises. All food sold is for on-property consumption in accordance with Pennsylvania health code.

TEE SHEET/CART ASSIGNMENTS/SKILL PRIZES: A list of attendees (Pairing List & Alphabetical) and skill prizes must be provided at least 7 days in advance to The Pro Shop for scorecards, cart tags, and hole markers. These lists can be faxed/emailed/dropped off. The Links will assign starting holes for the foursomes provided. Outings of less than 80 golfers are not guaranteed a group per hole start. Doubling up starting holes will be done to facilitate regular play. If additional golf carts are rented at the request of your group, the fees will be passed along to you.

COURSE CONDITIONS: The Links will endeavor to present the golf course in the best possible playing condition for your event. As long as the golf course is deemed playable and all 18 holes are available, no allowances will be given. From time-to-time, course maintenance will be performed, weather-permitting. Maintenance will not be performed on the day of your event. However, weather may restrict play to cart path only play.

GOLF CART LIABILITY WAIVER The Links allows for the use of golf carts for golf outings and picture taking on the course property. All cart operators must be 16 or older to comply with insurance requirements. Cart fees for golfers and spectators will be charged to the group. In exchange for the use of these golf cart(s) you are accepting the responsibility of everyone in your event group who will be operating the cart(s). All person(s) must operate the cart(s) in a safe manner and adhere to all rules set forth by The Links. By signing this contract you are agreeing to accept the risk of using a golf cart(s) and agree to pay for any damages to the cart(s) or damage done to the course. You agree to accept the risks of using a golf cart(s) and on behalf of yourself and your personal representatives hereby release The Links at Spring Church, its owners, employees and agents from any and all claims, actions, causes of actions, suits, judgments and demands for bodily injury, loss of like and/or loss of services that may in any way manner arise out of use of the golf cart.

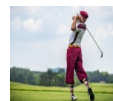

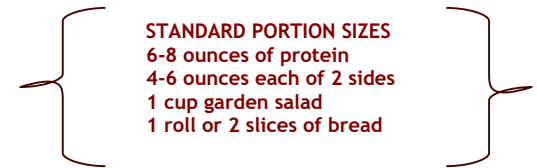

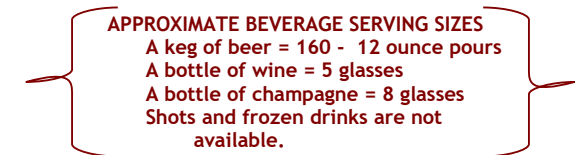
PORTION CONTROL

- All pricing is per person and includes tax and 30% gratuity.
- The Links prepares standard portion sizes for each menu item.
- All menus are served buffet style and you are responsible for ordering sufficient quantities based upon your group's demographics.
- If refreshments are not provided at the turn, the food consumption rate may be higher.
- You can avoid food shortages by requesting extra portions which will be priced accordingly.



ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

House wines and canned beer are charged by consumption. Kegs of beer, pre-mixed cocktails, and specialty wines (including champagne) are pre-sold and cannot be returned nor can they be taken with you if not used. Alcoholic beverages may not be brought in or removed from the property.



Alcoholic beverage sales are governed by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, and are subject to the laws of the State of PA.

Our servers and bartenders are trained in responsible beverage service. Their decision is final in all matters pertaining to refusal of service of intoxicated patrons. PLCB requirements will be followed for documentation of intoxicated patrons and the reporting of intoxicated patrons who refuse our offer of safe transportation. It is strongly recommended that organizers prearrange with The Links to assume charges for the safe transport of their guests. The group is responsible for the conduct of their players and guests.

All food and beverage products and services are provided by The Links at Spring Church. Due to State restrictions, liquor laws, and insurance coverage, all food and beverage items consumed at the facility (including the grounds, golf course, and clubhouse) must be purchased and served by The Links at Spring Church.
